>>> The 'Belem Letter', a document signed by a coalition of Brazilian social and environmental movements and civil society organizations, calls on the Government of Brazil to reject REDD as a carbon market-based mechanism compensating emissions from Northern countries. The critical voices from Brazil refuse a possible inclusion of incentives to monocultures as reforestation or the promotion of industrial logging under the banner of Sustainable Forest Management. >>> A just climate agreement depends on the willingness of developed countries to provide compensatory finance to Southern countries in order to address adaptation and mitigation needs while safe-guarding their right to sustainable development enabling a dignified life for all peoples. >>> Southern Africa suffers from extreme climate variability and communities, with women at the forefront, have for centuries developed strategies to adapt to its impacts - strategies that could be learned from and replicated. The workshop presents the findings of the study "Gender and Climate Change in Southern Africa" focusing on gender differentiated vulnerability, impacts and responses to climate change in southern Africa. Four case studies were developed under the project in South Africa, Botswana, Mozambique and Namibia respectively. The studies should be discussed in the workshop with experts and activists.
